- ◆ **Offered sessions 8 & 9**

This partial day program is offered from 10:00am until 2:00pm daily. Children participate in a variety of activities with emphasis on fun and exploration. Games, sports, ooey gooey science, messy mixtures, arts & crafts, nature activities will make the time fly by. Limited enrollment. No Transportation.

Camp White Tail

- ◆ **Age:** 5-8 (completion of Kindergarten recommended)
- ◆ **Cost:** \$170 per week, per child
- ◆ **Offered sessions 1,2,3,4,7,8,9,10**

Children participate in a variety of activities that they have chosen with emphasis on fun and exploration. Sports (soccer, t-ball & others), ooey gooey science, messy mixtures, edible art, learn about birds, dinosaurs & fossils, pirates & treasure, arts & crafts, and nature activities to name a few. Optional Family Camp-out July 29th.

Camp Ultimate

- ◆ **Age:** 8-13
- ◆ **Cost:** \$170 per week, per child
- ◆ **Offered sessions 1,2,3,4,7,8,9,10**

Designed to provide children a wide variety of activities from sports (soccer, lacrosse, golf, football, rollerblading, basketball, baseball), arts and crafts (drawing, cartooning, painting), science, crabbing, fishing, canoeing, hiking, exploring, group games, water games, drama, dance, puppetry and so much more. Optional Camp-outs on July 1st, 29th (family), August 5th & 12th.

Teen Leadership Trainee Program - Ages 14-16

...Learning, Teaching, Growing

Held at Sandy Point, this program (session 3–June 28-July 2) is designed to help today's teen develop their own sense of responsibility & leadership potential. LT's will participate in a variety of discussions & activities centered on personal growth and development. We will use Broadneck Park as our meeting point and venture daily from there. These camps are for older participants. Two full day excursions are combined with overnights planned for both Wednesday & Thursday nights each week to create a great camp experience.



High Adventure

◆ Age: 9-15

◆ Cost: \$325

◆ Session 5-July 12-16

Planned activities include the popular mountain coaster, group games, water zip lines, & canoeing/kayaking. Additional activities may include, all-terrain boards, mountain biking, tubing, caving, water slides, rock wall, or go carts. An **overnight** on Wednesday and Thursday at Deep Creek State Park provides a great backdrop for some exciting activities. Participants should be able to swim.

Water, Water, Water

◆ Age: 9-15

◆ Cost: \$325

◆ Session 6 - July 19-23

The emphasis is getting "wet". Excursions to area parks, beaches, pools and "swimming holes" should help beat the summer heat. An **overnight** on Wednesday and Thursday at Assateague State Park has us at the beach for three days of fun. We will check out the waves, visit a local water park, play ultimate on the beach, fly some kites, roast s'mores on a campfire and enjoy an evening having dinner in Ocean City. Participants must be able to swim.

TALS Camp - Ages 3- 5 (for children who have not yet attended kindergarten)

◆ Cost: \$110 per week, per child

◆ Offered sessions 1 & 2

Held at the TALS Early Childhood Program location in Annapolis (close to the mall). This program will run from 9:15am-12:15pm Monday through Friday. Every child will love the daily activities that provide for "hands on" fun. Offered weeks of June 14th – 18th & June 21st - 25th. Limited Enrollment. No transportation.
